You cannot participate without a physician-signed medical form. Do NOT mail completed medical forms to the national office or to your local council office. Bring your completed medical form to the course and submit it upon arrival.

- Bring your completed and signed medical form and a copy of your health insurance card to the NYLT Leadership Academy check-in on your first day of course!



PARTICIPANT QUALIFICATIONS

This course is for Boy Scouts and Venturers who meet the following qualifications:

- Have completed your council National Youth Leadership Training (NYLT). If your council does not have a youth leader training program, you may still qualify by working with a council representative to become familiar with the NYLT Staff Guide.
- Have served, or have been recommended to serve, on the youth staff of your local council NYLT.
- First Class rank or above, or a Venturer.
- Fourteen years of age by the opening day of course, but not yet 18; or if a Venturer, not yet 21.
- Willingness to take back to your Council NYLT the knowledge and skills acquired.
